AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FOR ALL CORPORATE PURPOSES OF THE VILLAGE OF TAMPICO, WHITESIDE COUNTY, ILLINIOS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2013 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2014

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Village Council of the Village of Tampico, Whiteside County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: That the amount hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, and as may be needed or deemed necessary to defray all expenses and liabilities of the Village of Tampico, Whiteside County, Illinois, as hereinafter specified for the Fiscal Year beginning May 1, 2013 and ending April 30, 2014.
